Initial Interview Weight/Height:

Initial Interview flowcharts can have special coded questions built specifically for documenting admission weight/height. Data documented on these questions will populate the Admission Weight and Height fields in Clinical Information. If weight and height have been previously entered anywhere in the system, they will display in the box when it is opened. (*Select Thrive UX > System Menu > Hospital Base Menu > POC Access > POC Whiteboard > Patient > Flow Chart Menu > Flow Chart > Weight and Height/Length*)

• Previously, this question would turn red once it was answered on a flow chart. Now the question will turn red if admit weight has been entered anywhere in the system (i.e. Clinical Information, Census, etc.).

- At this time, there is no functionality to take the user to the next question on the flow chart after launching Vitals, selecting update and returning to the flow chart.
- Initial Interview Weight/Height does not create a date/time column when charted and the answers will not appear on the flow chart.
- If the Initial Interview Weight/Height is modified, the new entry will be recorded as the first weight in Point of Care. To modify the entry, simply select the question again and document.
- After the user selects Update, they will be taken back to the flow chart screen. There is also a back arrow that will take users back to the flow chart if needed.

Vital Signs Weight/Height:

Flowcharts can also be built with hard coded weight/height questions to be used as a part of routine vital signs. They function differently from the Initial Interview Weight/Height question and they are not interchangeable. Entries update Current Weight throughout the system. (Select Thrive UX > System Menu > Hospital Base Menu > POC Access > POC Whiteboard > Patient > Flow Chart Menu > Flow Chart > Weight/Length)

- Vital Signs Weight/Height will now launch the CW5 Vital Signs application. Only those fields that fall under the Weight/Height heading in the Vitals application will display when the screen is launched.
- The entry will have the date/time of the flow chart column that documentation is being done in.
- After the user selects Update, they will be taken back to the flow chart screen. There is also a back arrow that will take users back to the flow chart if needed.
- At this time, there is no functionality to take the user to the next question on the flow chart after launching Vitals, selecting update and returning to the flow chart.
 - Default Scale setup can be done in the Vital Signs Ranges Table.
 - Tables > Clinical > Vital Sign Ranges
 - This is set up at the department level.

Documenting Flow Chart Height/Weight

• Clicking in a cell on the flow chart that has documentation for that date/time launches the current review screen. If user clicks Amend, CW5 Vitals screen launches with the weight/height fields populated. At this point, if the user chooses not to amend the entries, the data previously entered on this screen will be removed. Once Amend is selected, new values should be entered unless the intent is for the entries to be removed.
