


The **Patient Medication List** offers several filtering options for viewing medications and allows the process of administering medications without requiring access to a specific patient's account.

- To administer medications from the Patient Medication List, scan the patient's armband to launch directly to the MAR.
- Double-clicking on one of the medications in the list will also launch the patient's MAR.

Select the applicable filters to categorize the information needed on the medication list.

PATH: Select Charts > Medication Verification



The filter available for selection include:

- Nurse Filters: My Patients
- Department Filters: Department (Med Surg, ICU, etc.)
- Pharmacy Order Filters: Non-IV, IV, Controlled Substances, Diabetic Record, Treatment, Linked, Antimicrobial Orders
- Frequency Filters: X1, Stat, Diabetic Record
- Scheduled Filters: Due, Scheduled, PRN
- The filters can be setup on the role or facility. Users also have the option of creating their own. See the [Updated EMAR/MedVerify User Guide](#) and [Filter Builder](#) document for more information regarding the filter options and how to create the filters.

Select the date/time range to filter the information needed on the medication list.

- The date/time range feature reduces the amount of data on the screen and will only display what is within that specific timeframe for the filters selected.
- The times (not the date) are will be remembered when returning to the Patient Medication List screen the next day.
 - Example: In the screenshot above, the range is set for 0700-1900 on 9/12/22. The following day, the same 0700-1900 time will display but the date will change to 9/13/22.

To export a PDF of the filters selected from the Patient Medication List, select the PDF option and the selections made will be displayed in a report that may be printed if desired.

NOTE: If previous administrations need to be checked, refer back to the EMAR or Medication Report. The PDF format is only as accurate as the date/time it is printed so it is best to only use this tool for pulling medications and utilize the MAR application when administering medications.
