

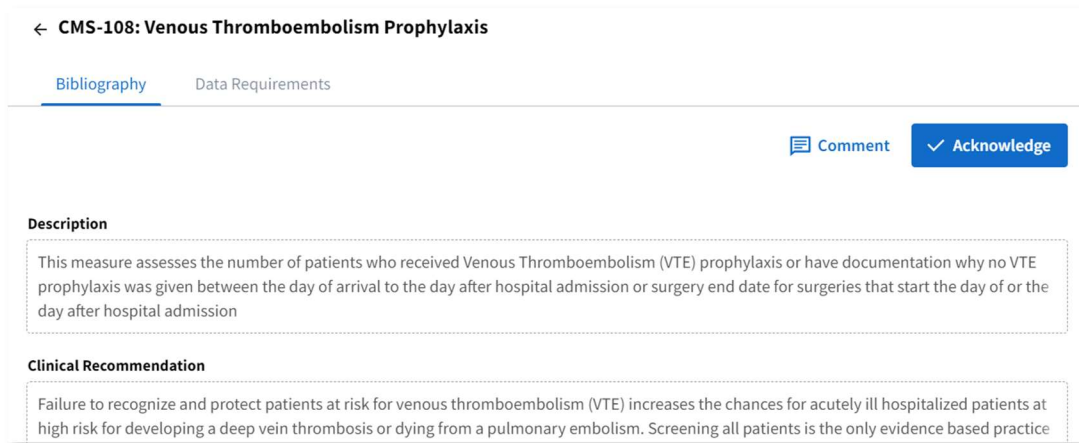
Decision Support Interventions (DSI) are designed to assist clinicians by prompting for the clinical care to be provided based on information already addressed on the patient chart. This functionality will replace the existing Clinical Decision Support (CDS Alert) functionality.

DSI alerts are evidence-based and directly match Eligible Hospital Electronic Clinical Quality Measures (EH eQMs). The algorithm used to determine when a DSI should trigger will line up with the Denominator Population Criteria on the eQM Roadmap associated with the DSI.

Reviewing and Acknowledging DSI

When a DSI is triggered on a patient, the DSI will populate to the Alerts screen for review. Alerts yet to be acknowledged will display. Once an alert has been acknowledged, it will no longer display on the screen.

Path: **Charts > Tracking Board > Select the patient > Alerts > Select the DSI > Acknowledge**

Description

This measure assesses the number of patients who received Venous Thromboembolism (VTE) prophylaxis or have documentation why no VTE prophylaxis was given between the day of arrival to the day after hospital admission or surgery end date for surgeries that start the day of or the day after hospital admission

Clinical Recommendation

Failure to recognize and protect patients at risk for venous thromboembolism (VTE) increases the chances for acutely ill hospitalized patients at high risk for developing a deep vein thrombosis or dying from a pulmonary embolism. Screening all patients is the only evidence based practice

From the DSI, the user can review the Bibliographic Information and the Data Requirements associated with the measure. This is a view only functionality and will display whatever is associated with the measure via DSI Configuration in Tables.

Providing Feedback on DSI


Users may also have the option to provide feedback on a DSI from the patient review screen, if they have the necessary behavior control (Provide DSI Feedback). This feedback will be specific to the DSI itself, and **will not** populate to the patient chart. Any documentation about the DSI that should be associated with the patient in question should be entered through a documentation platform. Using the **Comment** option, users can review previously entered comments and enter additional feedback as well.

Path: **Charts > Tracking Board > Select the patient > Alerts > Select the DSI > Comment**
